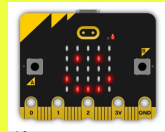

Children make a series of circuits using buzzers, bulbs, switches and propellers. They will be learning about insulators and conductors by working scientifically. They will know where energy comes from and how to use electricity safely.

During the Spring term we are focusing on multiplication and division. We will be looking at more formal methods of multiplication and division using concrete manipulatives. Children will also be learning to find the length, area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes, measuring in mm, cm, m and km.

Geography

Class 3 will be finding out about our planet and how volcanoes are formed. Children will investigate the causes and effects of Volcanoes, Tsunamis and Earthquakes. They will learn about the 'Ring of Fire' and how to use cardinal compass points in mapping.
