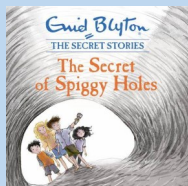


Reading:

Year 1 Phonics:

The children are following the Floppy Phonics scheme, which your child can access at home and complete the books and activities for the sounds they are learning at school. The username and password are in your child's reading log, along with which book to complete at home.

Writing:

Our key text is The Secret of Black Rock by Joe Todd-Stanton. The children will be immersed in the text and will write their version of the story. They will also write a diary from the main character's point of view, thinking about how certain situations could make you feel.

Maths:

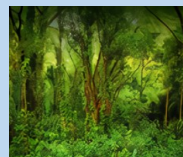
Year 1 will be learning about number and place value to 10, before moving on to addition and subtraction.
Year 2 will be learning about place value and addition and subtraction within 100, identifying different ways they could solve problems. They will also continue to focus on their arithmetic skills.

Geography:

Our focus this half term is Coastlines, where the children are focusing on:
~ Human and physical features of coastlines
~ Reading and studying maps with keys
~ The names of the five oceans in the world
~ Grace Darling

Science:

The children will be exploring living things and their habitats. They will explore habitats local to the school, before identifying different habitats and why animals are suited to each one.



RE:

This term, our topic is called 'Who do Christians say made the world?' The children will learn the creation story from the bible and how that impacts the way they believe our planet should be treated.

Art:

In art, the children are learning about Joan Miro and how he uses surrealism and magical realism to create his artwork.



Computing:

This half term the children are focusing on how to keep safe online and how to effectively and safely search the internet.

PSHE:

Our focus this term is Being Me in My World. The children will look at hopes and fears for the year, rewards and consequences and they will create a learning charter for our class.

Music:

The children are learning about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch using a song entitled 'Hey You!' and other old school hip hop songs.

PE:

The children will be focusing on gymnastics and dance. In gymnastics, they will develop control and stability when performing balances. In dance, they will make and perform actions to create a pirate inspired dance.
