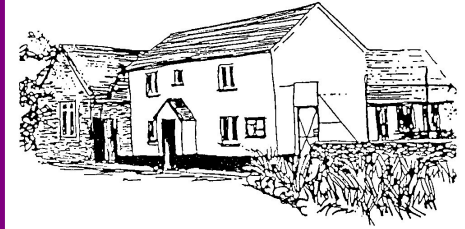


Reading:

Our class shared text this half term is 'Journey to the River Sea' by Eva Ibbotson. Children are asked to read their 'reading levelled books daily at home. They also have a library book of their choosing to read and

Class 3

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Guided reading Sessions:

The children will look at a range of fiction and non fiction texts in our guided reading sessions. They will develop their skills in understanding vocabulary, selecting key information and using inference and deduction to answer a range of comprehension questions.

Writing:



Our key text is The Whale. The children will explore settings, using description and a range of writing devices to create their own fantastic settings that help paint a picture in our readers' head.

Maths:

Our maths will explore that value of each digit within a number, ordering and rounding numbers and representing numbers in different ways. We will then use this knowledge to apply to addition and subtraction calculations using our methods and strategies to solve a range of worded problems.



Geography:

Our geography topic this half term focuses on rivers. We will be looking at river features and how the Water Cycle works. The children will explore different rivers across the UK before looking at rivers that can be found around the world.



Science:



Our science topic will explore Plants, looking at what a plant needs to survive, different types of plants we have available and where do plants grow. The children will grow their own plants and carry out a range of experiments.

RE:

This half term, our topic will explore 'What is it like for someone who follows God? Pupils will learn about the Old Testament people of God and how they lived their lives.



Art:

In art, the children will look at a range of artists, exploring landscapes and city scapes before using these ideas to create their own masterpieces.



Computing:

This half term the children are focusing on how to keep safe online and how to effectively and safely search the internet.

PSHE:

Our focus this half term is Being Me in My World. The children will understand the importance of being individual and create targets for the year based on their own strengths and areas for development.

Music:

The children will be learning how to play the recorder. We will look at how we hold the recorder correctly, positioning our fingers to enable us to play a tune.
