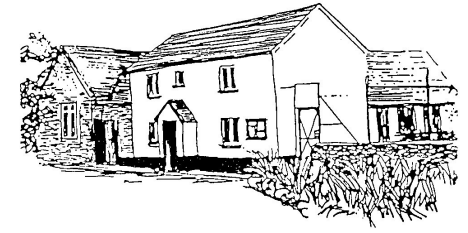

Writing:
