

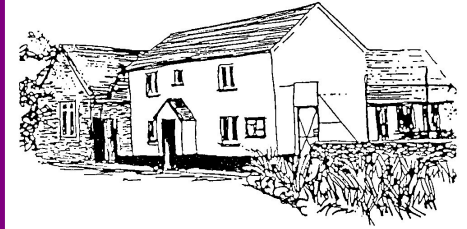
### Reading:

# Class 2 Summer Term Curriculum Newsletter



### Year 1 Phonics:

The children are following the Floppy Phonics scheme, which your child can access at home and complete the books and activities for the sounds they are learning at school. The username and password are in your child's reading log, along with which book to complete at home.

### History:

Our focus this term is Towers, Tunnels and Turrets, where the children are focusing on:

- ~ Castles through the ages
- ~ Motte and Bailey Castles
- ~ What life was like in a castle for a Norman
- ~ The Battle of Hastings
- ~ Investigating Towers

### Art:

In art, the children are looking closely at William Morris' motifs, drawing flowers and leaves and creating a symmetrical design, which they will print.



### Writing:

Our key text is Rapunzel. The children will be immersed in the story of Rapunzel and writing their version as a traditional tale. They will also learn to write instructions through creating spells, with a plan to catch Rapunzel's witch.

### RE:

This term, our topic is called 'Who is Muslim and how do they live?' The children will share stories about the prophet and think about how they guide Muslims and can teach us all good behaviour.

### PSHE:

Our focuses this term are Relationships and Changing Me. The children will look at what healthy relationships look like, how they change and grow and how to manage their feelings.

### Computing:

This term the children are focusing on what spreadsheets are and how to use them, before moving on to focus on pictograms.

### French:

The children will be learning the colours of the rainbow and some simple weather phrases. They will focus on our body parts through songs.

### Music:

The children are learning about Opera and how to sing dramatically through the story of Hansel and Gretel.

### Maths:

Year 1 will be learning about multiplication and division, position and direction and time. Year 2 will be learning about fractions, money and position and direction. They will all continue working on their arithmetic and problem solving skills.

### Science:

The children will be exploring uses of everyday materials, investigating the suitability of different materials and how easily they can change shape.



### PE:

The children will be focusing on striking and fielding, where they will develop their throwing and batting skills. They will then focus on learning and developing different athletic movements.
